Through its range of Corporate Citizenship activities, AIG's aim is make a collective impact in communities through collaboration with local partners across the globe. The partnership with JCV on this particular program has been in place since 2007 and donations are made based on the number of new "Minna no kenpo" medical insurance contracts AIG General receives. This year's donation corresponds to the 2017 total number of such contracts and will provide polio vaccines for 45,200 people.
