AIG General forms Partnership Agreement with Working with Cancer *Ouendan*

First initiative will be publication of Cancer-focused Disaster Prevention Manual for SMEs®

TOKYO – June 19, 2023 – AIG General Insurance Company, Ltd. (AIG General) today signed a partnership agreement on cancer awareness activities with Working with Cancer *Ouendan*, a General Incorporated Association. The first combined initiative will be the publication of a Cancer-focused Disaster Prevention Manual for Small and Medium-sized Enterprises (SMEs).

In recent years, the number of cancer patients in the working age group between 15 and 64 has been on the rise. At the same time, advances in medical care have led to a shift in medical care for cancer from hospitalization to outpatient treatment. In June 2019, AIG General launched an industry-leading rider that provides coverage for outpatient treatment expenses for cancer – this was well received by SMEs to help employees continue to work while undergoing cancer treatment. Working with Cancer *Ouendan* engages with various specialists to support balancing medical treatment and work, aiming to reduce the challenges faced by working-age cancer survivors.

AIG General has a history of helping SMEs in Japan, including the launch of the SME Resilience Project to help strengthen business continuity capabilities. This focus on supporting SMEs and recognizing the high affinity of Working with Cancer *Ouendan* formed the basis of the partnership agreement and will act as the foundation for future initiatives.

The first initiative under this agreement will be to develop and publish a Cancer-focused Disaster Prevention Manual for SMEs. Working with Cancer *Ouendan* emphasizes the need for disaster prevention manuals, based on the idea that cancer, like other natural disasters, can suddenly strike anyone. To encourage individuals to be prepared, the jointly developed manual will be developed and delivered to SMEs through AIG's agents and sales staff to provide information on the support needed by employees dealing with cancer along with specific ways to create a workplace where employees can continue to work with peace of mind even while managing a cancer diagnosis.
